## **Government Ministers and Senior Officials Meet to Discuss Policies**

Government ministers and senior officials were engaged in a crucial meeting aimed at shaping the future direction of the Virgin Islands today.

The event brought together ministers, permanent secretaries, department heads, to engage in critical discussions focused on the operationalisation of key legislative measures and strategic plans for the Territory.

Premier and Minister of Finance, Honourable Dr. Natalio Wheatley, shared insights into strengthening government communication and policy effectiveness.

Premier Wheatley said, "As we move forward, it is essential that we work collaboratively to ensure that the Virgin Islands continues to grow and thrive.
