Two Schools Advance in Inter-Secondary School Preliminary Debates

St. George's Secondary School and the Virgin Islands School of Technical Studies (VISTS) are the winners in the first round of the Ministry of Education's annual Inter-Secondary School debates.

The winners will compete in the Semi-Final Round on 26th February. St. George's will face the Virgin Islands School of Technical Studies, while the Bregado Flax Educational Centre Secondary Division will engage the Elmore Stoutt High School.
