BVI Post Suspends Package Shipments to the U.S.A. Following New Tariff Policy

Release Date: 29 August, 2025



The BVI Postal Service has announced the temporary suspension of mail items containing goods bound for the United States and its territories (American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands) effective **Friday, 29th August 2025**, until further notice.

This follows the introduction of **U.S. Executive Order 14324**, which eliminates the duty-free *de minimis* exemption and requires all international parcels, regardless of value, to be subject to U.S. import duties. The order takes effect immediately.

Please note that this Executive Order does **not** affect the acceptance or processing of letters and documents. The BVI Postal Service will continue to facilitate shipments of these items to the United States without interruption.
