
Special Announcement by Premier Wheatley

I come before you today to announce a significant change to my administration.

I am extremely pleased to welcome Hon. Stacy Mather into the government to strengthen our ability to deliver for the people of the Virgin Islands.

I have known Stacy since our days of attending the then BVI High School.
