Public Advisory: Fraudulent ED Card Website

The Department of Immigration is alerting the public to a fraudulent website that is falsely representing itself as the official Government platform for applications for an Online ED Card for the Territory of the Virgin Islands and is unlawfully charging a fee to enter the Territory.

The public is advised that this website is **NOT** affiliated with the Government of the Virgin Islands.

The **ONLY** official website to be used for obtaining an Online ED Card for the Virgin Islands is **BVIEDCARD.GOV.VG**. Please note:

- There are **NO other authorised websites** for this service.
- There is **NO charge** to obtain an Online ED Card to enter The Virgin Islands.

Members of the public are strongly urged not to provide personal information or make any payments on unauthorised websites claiming to facilitate entry into the Territory.
