Recall of Pâté en Croûte, Cocktail Pistache

Release Date: 12 March, 2026



The Environmental Health Division is advising the public of the immediate **recall of the product Pâté en Croûte Cocktail Pistache (400g), produced by the brand Drôme Salaisons.**

The recall was issued following reports that the product may be contaminated with **Listeria**, a harmful bacterium that can cause serious illness.

Product Details:

- Product Name: Pâté en Croûte Cocktail Pistache
- Brand: Drôme Salaisons
- Size: 400g
- Affected Batches: Products with a **use-by date between 17 February 2026 and 31 March 2026**

This product has been distributed internationally, **including the British Virgin Islands.** Members of the public who may have purchased this product are **advised not to consume it.** The product should be **discarded immediately.**

Food contaminated with Listeria can cause **Listeriosis**, a serious infection. Symptoms may include fever, muscle aches, headaches, stiff neck, confusion, loss of balance, and stomach-related symptoms such as diarrhea.

Listeriosis can be especially dangerous for **pregnant women, older adults, newborn babies, and persons with weakened immune systems.**
