Premier and Minister responsible for Agriculture and Fisheries, Honourable Dr. Natalio D. Wheatley, said this year's event serves as a critical platform for local producers to boost their visibility and for the community to reconnect with the traditions that sustain the Virgin Islands. He emphasised the government's steadfast support for the industry, stating, "Our farmers and fishers are the backbone of our resilience. By continuing to invest in and emphasise the importance of this sector, we are not just growing food; we are securing our future. I encourage all our local producers to take this opportunity to boost their output and join us in nourishing the lives and legacies of the Virgin Islands."

The 2026 celebrations will commence with the Opening Ceremony and Harvest Parade/Procession at the Eileene L. Parsons Auditorium, H. Lavity Stoutt Community College, Paraquita Bay, Tortola, on 10th April 2026 at 4:00 p.m. The activities will then move to the Road Town Festival Grounds for the Exhibition and Market on 11th and 12th April, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily.

Attendees can look forward to a diverse range of fun activities and learning opportunities designed for the entire family, including various competitions, games, and displays of agricultural produce and animals, interactive demonstrations and live musical entertainment.

Registration is now officially open for vendors and those wishing to enter the Livestock and Crop competitions.
