**CABINET DECISIONS** 

11<sup>th</sup> December, 2024

## Cabinet Meeting – 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2024

His Excellency, the Governor Mr. Daniel Pruce, chaired the meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2024 at the Premier's Conference Room.

All Members were present.

Cabinet:

- 1. Noted the content of the Governor's Office Commission of Inquiry Outstanding Recommendations for the week of 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2024.
- 2. Decided that the 2025 White, Toyota Prado, the new emergency response vehicle, for the BVI Red Cross, be exempt from import duty, in accordance with Schedule 5, paragraph 2(a) of the Customs Management and Duties Act, 2010.
- 3. Considered and approved:
  - a. the Cruising and Home Port Permit (Amendment) Bill, 2024 to amend the Cruising and Home Port Permit Act, 2021, No. 29 of 2021;
  - b. the Customs Management and Duties (Amendment) Bill, 2024 to amend the Customs Management and Duties Act, 2010, No. 6 of 2010;
  - c. the Cruising and Home Port Permit (Amendment of Schedule 2) Order, 2024;
  - d. the Statutory Rates, Fees and Charges (Amendment of Schedule) Order, 2024 subject to an affirmative resolution;
  - e. that the following Bills be introduced for their first reading at the next convenient sitting of the House of Assembly:
    - i. Commercial Recreational Vessels Licensing (Amendment) Bill, 2024
    - ii. Customs Management and Duties (Amendment) Bill, 2024
    - iii. Cruising and Home Port Permit (Amendment) Bill, 2024

- f. that the Cruising and Home Port Permit (Amendment of Schedule 2) Order, 2024 and Statutory Rates, Fees and Charges (Amendment of Schedule) Order, 2024 be published in the Virgin Islands Official Gazette and thereafter the Orders and affirmative Resolution be laid on the table in the House of Assembly.
- 4. Considered and approved:
  - a. that pursuant to section 4 of the Financial Services Appeal Board Act, the following persons be appointed as members of the Financial Services Appeal Board:
    - Ms. Arabella di Iorio, Chairman three (3) years (1<sup>st</sup> December, 2024 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2027)
    - ii. Mrs. Hazel-Ann Hannaway Boreland four (4) years (1<sup>st</sup> December, 2024 – 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2028)
    - iii. Ms. Brittney Smith one (1) year (1<sup>st</sup> December, 2024 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2025)
  - b. that pursuant to section 10 of the Financial Services Appeal Board Act, a remuneration be paid to the members of the Financial Services Appeal Board:
    - i. Chairman \$ 600 per month
    - ii. Members \$ 500 per month
- Decided to appoint the following persons to the Social Security Board Appeals Tribunal for a period of two (2) years with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2024, in accordance with section 5(2)(a) of the Social Security (Decisions and Appeals) (Amendment) Regulations, 1997:
  - a. that Mr. Michael Maduro be appointed as a member and Chairman; Ms. Lorna Christopher be re-appointed as a member representing employers and Ms. Solika Carey be appointed as a member of the Board representing employees; and noted
  - b. that in accordance with Section 34 of the Social Security Ordinance (CAP 266), that the Chairman would be paid one thousand dollars (\$1000) and Members eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) a month, respectively, from the Social Security Fund.
- 6. Noted that pursuant to section 13 of the Financial Services (Exceptional Circumstances) Act, 2020, the following persons were appointed to serve as members of the Financial Services Complaints Tribunal for a period of:

- a. three (3) years with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2027:
  - i. Mr. Peter Tarn Chairperson
  - ii. Mrs. Thelma Penn Member
  - iii. Mr. Sjoerd Koster Member
- b. two (2) years with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2026:
  - i. Ms. Eleanor Smith Member
  - ii. Mr. Cedric Dawson Member
