The Premier's Office invites applications from experienced maritime professionals for the position of **Chairperson of the Maritime Advisory Board**.

ABOUT THE MARITIME AUTHORITY BOARD

In accordance with Section 454 (1) of the Merchant Shipping Act, 2021 (the "Act"), a Board must be established under the name of "Maritime Advisory Board" (the "Board"). The purpose of the Board is to provide expert guidance and strategic advice pertaining to the maritime industry.

The Chairperson plays a pivotal role in ensuring effective maritime governance and safeguarding national interests. The position is crucial for overseeing maritime policies, regulations, and initiatives that contribute to the sustainable development and security of our nation's maritime domain."

The primary functions of the Board as outlined in Schedule 4; Section 2 of the Act are:

1. to advise the Minister on matters relating to the making or amendment of any regulations or rules made under this Act and any other matter relating to this Act as the Minister may request;
2. to advise the Minister on such matters relating to his duties under this Act as the Minister may request;

3. to perform such other tasks as the Minister may determine and report to the Minister at such times as the Minister requires.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CHAIRPERSON

Schedule 4, Section 1 (1) of the Act states that membership of the Board should include a Chairperson.

A person appointed to the Board shall be a person of high integrity, capable of exercising competence, diligence, sound judgment and impartiality in fulfilling his or her duties pursuant to the Act.

TERMS OF SERVICE

As stipulated in the Act, members of the Board shall hold office for a period not exceeding two years from the date of appointment and shall be eligible for reappointment.

REMUNERATION

Stipend-based remuneration.

Skills and Competencies Required:
Persons expressing an interest to serve as Chairperson of the Board should be knowledgeable and well-versed in matters pertaining to maritime industry.
