PUBLIC NOTICE

Scheduled CAPS Migration & Temporary Manual Declaration Process

The Customs Automated Processing System (CAPS) will undergo a **scheduled migration on Friday, 21st November 2025**, beginning at **4:30 PM**. During this time, the system will be offline and **unavailable to importers and brokers** until works are completed and the system is tested.

System access is expected to resume on Monday, 24th November 2025.

In the interim, all Trader Declarations (TDs) must be submitted manually using the HMC-12-2024 Version 2 Form.

Important Instructions for Importers and Brokers

Before System Shutdown – Friday, 21st November 2025, 4:30 PM

- Brokers must NOT attempt to submit any TD after 4:30 PM.
- Brokers should ensure that all TDs submitted before 4:30 PM have been properly processed.
 - Contact the Customs Office if you have pending entries to avoid declarations being stuck in the system.
- If you are unable to complete processing before this time, please:
 - o Print the TD details and walk in the declaration on Saturday, OR
 - Prepare the TD in CAPS beforehand, validate for accuracy, do NOT submit, and print all information for walk-in submission. (Option 2)

Manual Declaration Requirements

- All TDs must be prepared on the HMC-12-2024 Version 2 (Excel) Form.
- No handwritten TDs will be accepted.
- Importers must **physically walk in declarations** to the designated location.
- Brokers must ensure that all persons clearing cargo are registered with CAPS before presenting declarations.

Standing Deposits

- Couriers and businesses using **standing deposits** must:
 - o Submit declarations using the **HMC-12-2024 Form**, and
 - Select the importer type "Deposit."

System Resumption

CAPS is expected to return to full service on:

Monday, 24th November 2025.

An updated public notice will be issued upon successful completion of the migration and system validation.

Reminder

To avoid delays in cargo clearance:

- Follow all instructions carefully.
- Ensure correctness of TDs prior to submission.
- Avoid leaving declarations pending after system shutdown.
