Students studying in the BVI Asia Abroad Scholarship Programme in Hong Kong & Macau participated in Hong Kong's Winter Food Festival held in the Hong Kong Exhibition & Conference Centre from 25th – 29th December 25th 2025.

The bi-annual Festival is a gastronomical event that brings together a diverse array of local and international cuisines in which Chinese and International travelers sample delicacies and food brands from across the world. BVI students Travis Thomas, Kimberly Cordez, Zyra Creque, and Shamorie Glasgow supported the festival's lone Caribbean booth "Kepstar Trading" under the theme "A Taste of the Caribbean".
